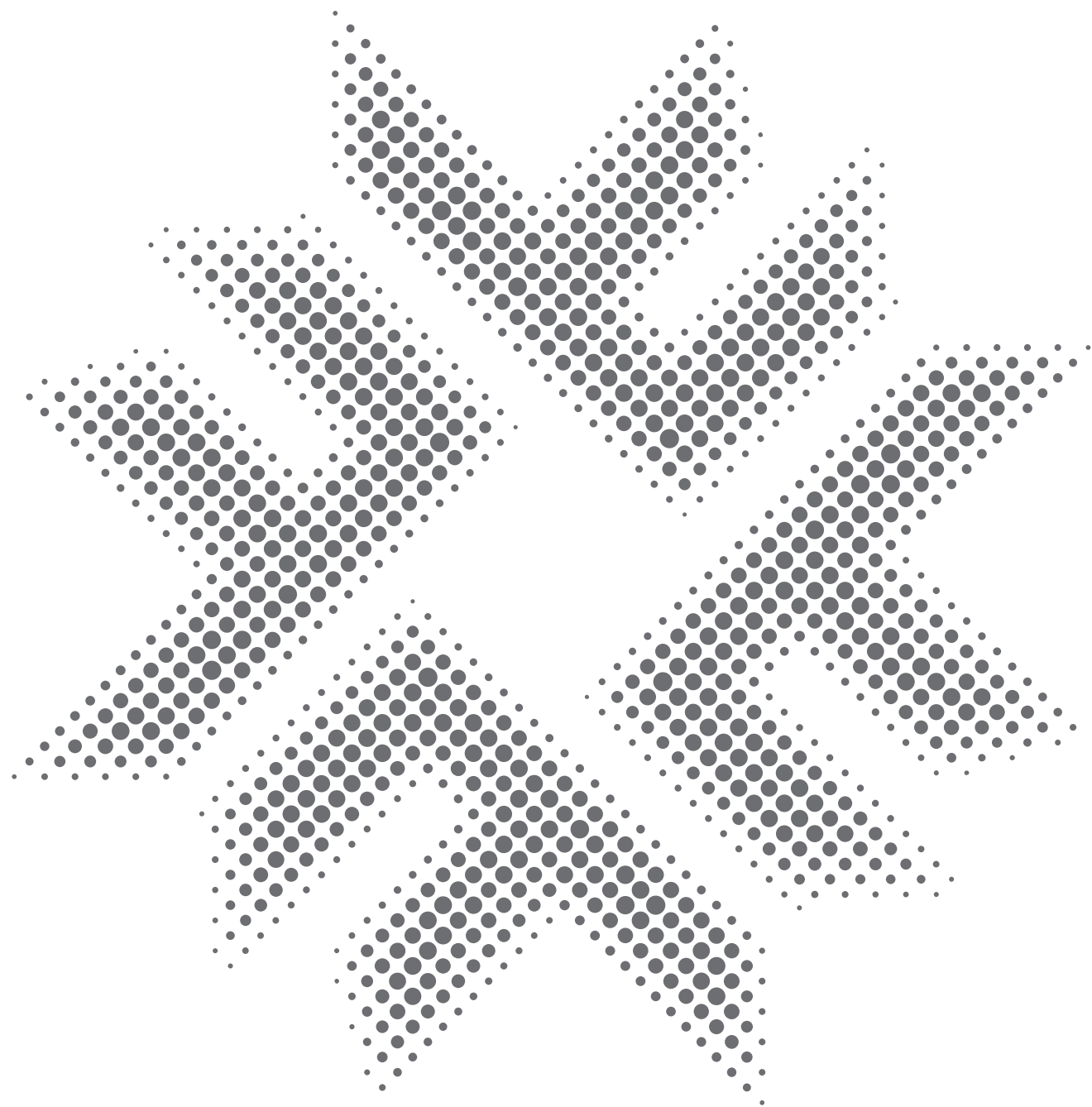

BREAKING IT DOWN

Your education is a major investment. Here are some yearly costs you'll need to consider to help you start planning now:

- ▶ Tuition fees for international students typically range from CAD 15,000 to CAD 16,000*
- ▶ Other expenses to consider include textbooks, a computer, housing, food, entertainment, etc. that can range from CAD 10,000 to CAD 12,000**
- ▶ A London Transit bus pass is included for full-time London campus students

*Tuition fees vary by program, including some that are much higher (eg. Aviation programs, Renewable Energies, etc.). For actual fees by program, visit fanshawec.ca/international/fees.

**This is only an estimate and depends on living situation, lifestyle and other course materials that may be required.

ENTRANCE SCHOLARSHIPS

If you're entering a full-time post-secondary program at Fanshawe for the first time, you may be eligible for an **International Entrance Scholarship**! Study in English, get full or partial credit for the courses you take and you may even be eligible for a scholarship up to \$2,500 per term to help lower your costs! 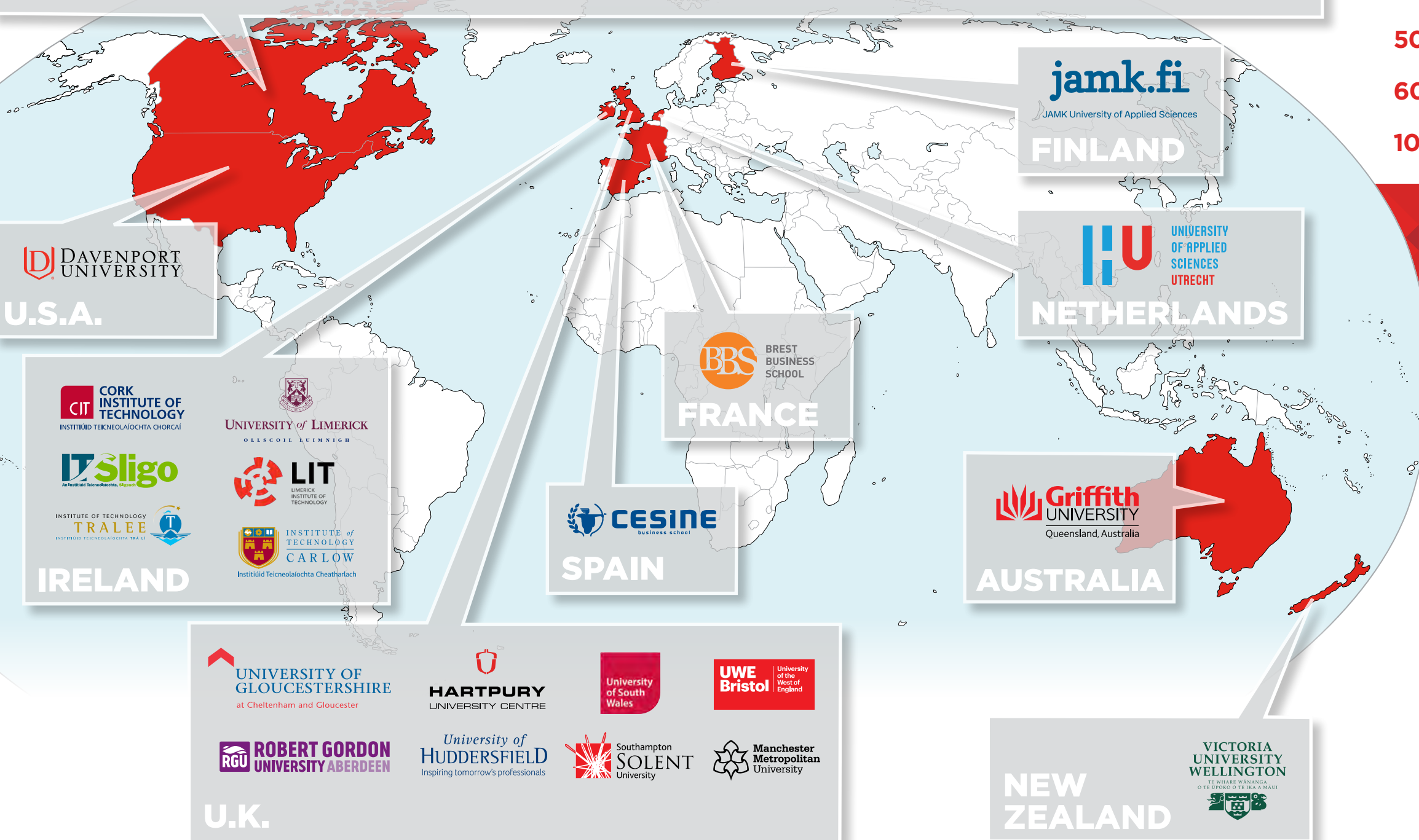

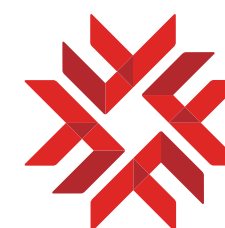

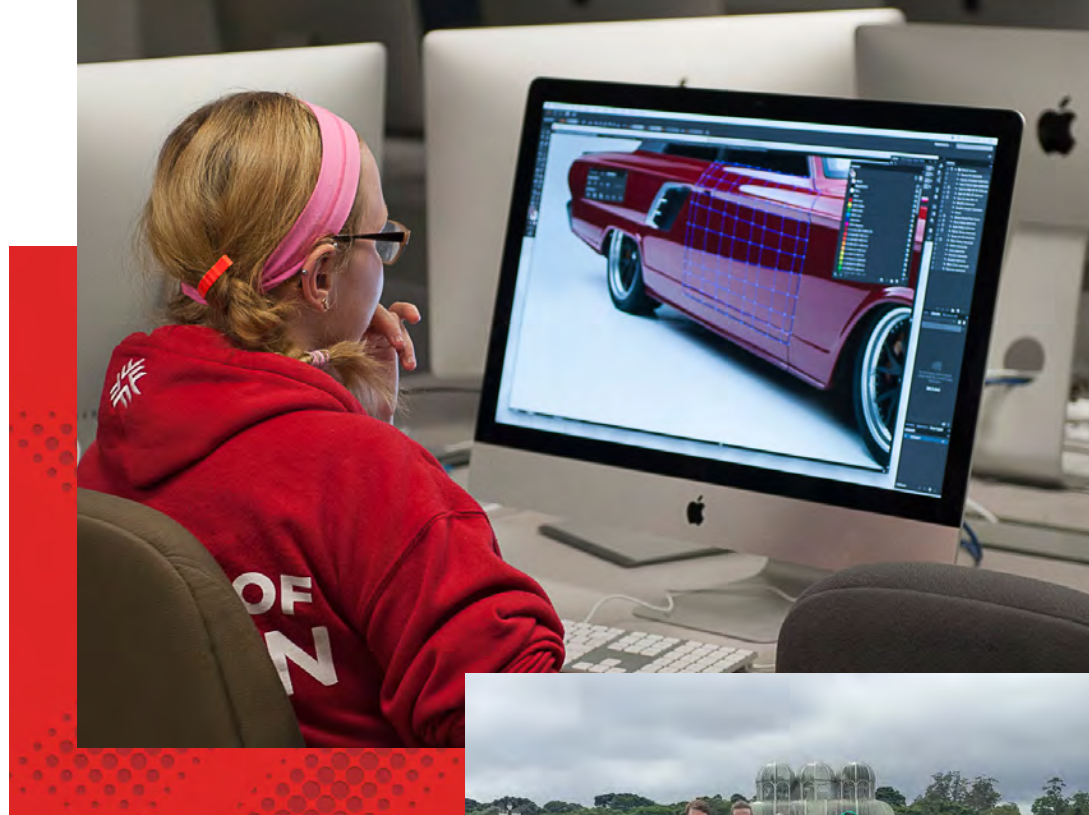

Are you looking to improve your English-speaking skills in order to prepare yourself for a post-secondary program in Canada? Then you've come to the right place. At Fanshawe College's English Language Institute (ELI), we'll help set you up for a successful academic journey ahead.

The ELI's English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program is certified by Languages Canada, offered year-round and is specifically designed to give you a direct route from English language training to post-secondary studies (both college and university level) with no further language testing required!

HOW EAP WORKS:

The full EAP program consists of 10 eight-week levels (two EAP levels per college term) and is delivered by 15 full-time instructors, three of whom hold Ph.D.s. Each EAP level consists of seven weeks of intensive training focusing on advanced English language skills and an eighth week of experiential learning activities like workshops, excursions and events.
