





No South Korean university offers a major in gerontology, so Dasom You chose USC as her destination of choice to build crucial knowledge in the field.

"USC is famous in Korea," she says, and the International Academy immediately helped make her feel welcome. In addition to forging lasting friendships with students from different nations and cultures, You also availed herself of the academy's skill-building programs.

"I had to write many research papers for my master's," she says. "The International Academy helped prepare me for that, and to make presentations."

That preparation, along with You's diligence and hard work, led her to graduate USC with a 4.0 average. She also credits the Davis School of Gerontology faculty for being "generous, warm-hearted, and always willing to help us to improve."

In addition, she took a course through the USC Marshall School of Business to expand her entrepreneurial abilities. "The professor was quick to give me advice and get me involved in class," You says.

She plans to return home to apply these tools to bolstering her family's business of designing and manufacturing massage chairs. She also wants to fight the loneliness she sees among the company's elderly customers. She found the course Technological Innovations in Aging particularly inspiring and wants to develop a social app to connect older people with each other.

You says she will be able to achieve all this, thanks to USC Davis School of Gerontology and USC International Academy.





Intensive English Program

Achieve your academic and professional goals through personalized English-language instruction, cultural activities, and support offered at six convenient start dates each year.

Tailored teaching in small, interactive classes

With levels of instruction from beginning to advanced, the Intensive English Program courses meet the needs of each student's unique skill set and goals. Class sizes are kept small and instruction is interactive, giving you the opportunity to receive individualized attention, collaborate with one another, and optimize your learning.

You will attend 20 hours of classes each week that focus on reading, writing, listening, speaking, and pronunciation. Tutoring and conversation groups are also available.

Optional SAT preparation

Students in Level 5 (equivalent to minimum TOEFL iBT 70 / IELTS 6) can choose to enroll in our SAT Preparation course, specifically designed to meet the needs of USC International Academy students, at an additional cost.

Undergraduate Admissions Workshops

Students looking to transition to a U.S. university or college can attend application and admissions workshops led by USC

advisers and USC International Academy partner institutions, some of which accept completion of an International Academy proficiency level in lieu of TOEFL/IELTS scores.

Focus skills courses and conversation groups geared to your interests

Each term, you will be able to choose a focus course and attend weekly conversation groups based on your current English-language proficiency and interests. Additionally, teacher-led drop-in tutoring and student-led conversation groups offer additional opportunities to practice English outside of the classroom. You will have meaningful opportunities to participate in English-related tutorials or practice conversation with USC students.


