General English Courses

Our General English course is designed to give you the English language skills to live, work, study and travel in an English-speaking environment.

During your General English course, you will meet with the Academic Manager and develop **clear learning objectives** based on your English language level and needs.

Your teachers will continuously monitor your progress throughout your English course and give **regular feedback and advice**.

The General English course covers all of the English language skills – speaking, listening, reading and writing with an emphasis on speaking and listening and a focus on **communication skills in real life settings**.

There is a maximum of 12 students per class catering for all levels from Elementary (CEF A1) to Proficiency (CEF C2).

General English and Private Lessons

Examination Preparation Courses

Having an **official, recognised qualification** in English is an important part in a student's overall language learning.

An increasing number of employers and universities are looking for English language examination results.

At Cork English Academy, we offer courses preparing students for the following examinations:

- Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE)
- International English Language Testing System (IELTS)

Examination Preparation courses are 6 weeks in duration and are run throughout the year.

Academic Year Programme

The Academic Year Programme is suitable for non-EU/EEA students. The **8-month programme** includes 25-weeks full-time English language tuition with the remaining 8 weeks as a holiday period.

Students will be registered to sit an official examination as part of their programme.

Students have the choice of the following 25-week tuition programmes:

- General English and Cambridge First Certificate in English (FCE) Preparation
- General English and International English Language Testing System (IELTS) Preparation
- General English and the Test of Interactive English (TIE) Examination

Students are entitled to work during this programme which offers a great opportunity for **maximising your English language usage**.

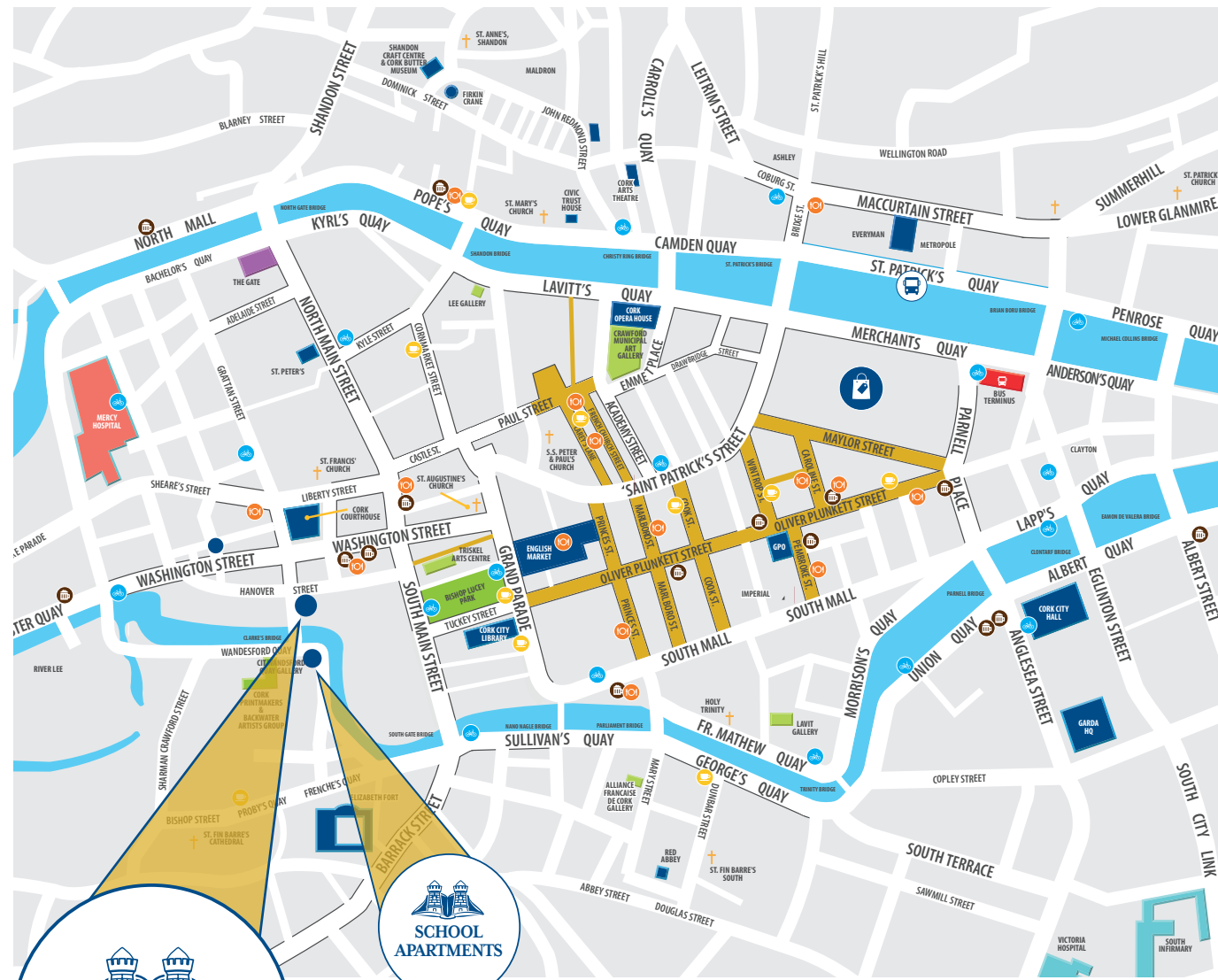
