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# Brighton

## Our exciting city

Brighton is one of the most cosmopolitan cities in the UK and located just 50 minutes from central London by train. It has much of what London has to offer; a significant difference being that Brighton is a seaside resort city.

Brighton is the UK's most popular seaside destination and a truly exciting city with its own identity. Brighton is a unique, upmarket and welcoming place mixing historic buildings, diverse nightlife, trendy boutiques, a rich theatrical and music scene, fabulous clubs and bars, family entertainment, eclectic shopping, 2 universities and a beach front which is one of the most visited in the UK. Not only that, but with the beautiful South Downs National Park close by, offering stunning scenery.

Brighton is famous for the Royal Pavilion; the home of King George IV (The Prince Regent) which he often visited as a holiday destination leading a luxurious lifestyle. Since the eighteenth century, Brighton has had the reputation for being a relaxed and vibrant city. Londoners have been travelling to Brighton and the beach ever since the railway arrived in 1841 to bathe in the sea and they still do today to get away from the pressures of city life. Brighton Palace Pier and the Royal Pavilion are the main sights, but you will also find hundreds of pubs and clubs attracting an energetic crowd. The city is now also home to the Brighton i360, the world's thinnest moving observation tower (162m) with views along the coast, across the South Downs and across the English Channel.

Brighton comes alive when the sun is shining; people fill the streets and visit the beach at every opportunity. Brighton is one of the lead cities in the UK to host a Pride festival, a celebration to promote equality and diversity (LGBTQ+). The major event is an annual summer festival held in the first week

of August which consists of a parade through the city centre, an event in Preston Park and the Kemp Town Village Party with major artists performing.

For a quieter place in the sun, go west along the seafront towards Hove and pass the old West Pier (Brighton's ghostly pier that caught on fire in 2003). Brighton is an all-season city and even though it can be crowded on a hot summer's day, it is still very busy all year round.

If the city-life is too much for you, you can always have a break in the fabulous South Downs National Park. Just take a bus or train and in 20 minutes you can be walking in the countryside or a historic town enjoying some of the most beautiful coastline views England has to offer.

If you like football, then you can visit the American Express Stadium and watch Brighton and Hove Albion (also known as "The Seagulls") who play in the premier league. In 2023/2024 Brighton & Hove Albion also qualified for their first UEFA Europa League campaign, they came first in their group and advanced to the knockout phase.

Whatever it is you are looking for to complement your studies and free time, Brighton has a lot to offer.

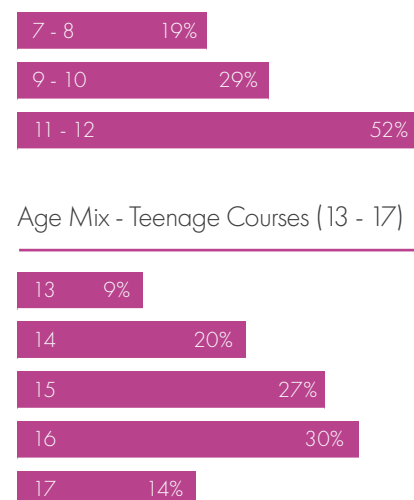

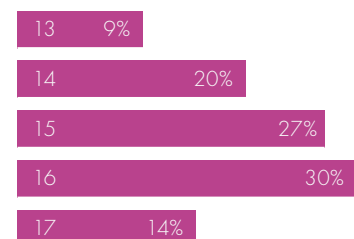
## Nationalities - Teenage Courses (13 - 17)

## School and environment

### Background

Brighton Language College International was established in 1995 and relocated in 2015 with a school covering 6 colour coded floors and over 1000m<sup>2</sup>. The school is situated in the city centre opposite the Royal Pavilion and only 2 minutes walk from the beach and Brighton Palace Pier & Sea Life Centre.

You are in the heart of the city each day of your studies, meaning you have all the benefits of Brighton's superb restaurants, beaches, night life, shops, entertainment and unique lifestyle in the UK's trendiest resort city.

BLC International operates from 2 buildings, 7 and 12 Old Steine. In the summer we also use the facilities of Brighton University City Centre Campus for our canteen lunch service.

# Teenage Courses (13-17)

## Courses for teenagers

Courses for teenagers are a complete package combining English classes, accommodation, activity programme and excursions for students from all over the world. In summer, BLC International uses the city centre facilities of the University of Brighton City Centre

Campus for hot lunches which are served on site. All courses for teenagers run 7 nights, Sunday to Sunday, for arrival and departure.

### Activities and Excursions

BLC International provides a weekly schedule of activities and excursions which are in the morning or afternoon. Students are shown the activity meeting point on their first day at BLC International and this is where they meet at set times with their activity leader. All activities are compulsory. After the activity, students must return to their homestay before their curfew.

### Accommodation

Students live with one of our experienced homestays who are within a 25 - 50 minute bus ride from the school.

Teenage vacation students are housed in a shared bedroom. Homestay accommodation encourages students to speak more English outside of the classroom and make new friends from around the world.

On the day of arrival the homestay provides information about the local buses and how to travel to and from school so they are prepared for their first day at BLC International. Homestays serve breakfast, lunch and dinner in the week. Hot lunches are provided by Brighton University for our Summer courses.

### Airport Transfers

#### Private transfers

For students not arriving or departing within our coach transfer times or from another UK airport a private taxi must be booked with BLCI to and from the accommodation. All airport arrivals must be no later than the times below for all transfer services.

Please note that students below the age of 16 travelling on their own must book a transfer from the airport or UK immigration may not allow them through arrivals.

#### Sunday Coach Transfer Service

BLC International provides transfers at the times below for students arriving and departing from Heathrow or Gatwick Airport on Sundays (please check the website for updates).

A BLC International representative will be waiting for students in the arrivals hall at the airport. Once the BLCI representative has collected students from the arrivals area, they are taken to a coach that is ready to go to our main school in Brighton.

Upon arrival at the school, a weekly Brighton bus pass is given to all teenage course junior students, who are then collected by their host and taken to their new home.

In 2025 we are also using a chaperoned Gatwick Express train service for some Gatwick departures.

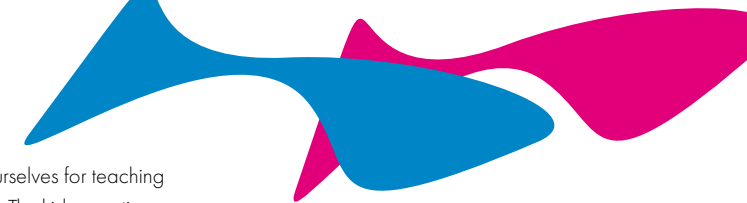
