Once settled in, students take part in fun ice-breaker games to meet each other and make friends.

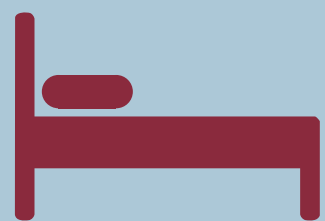

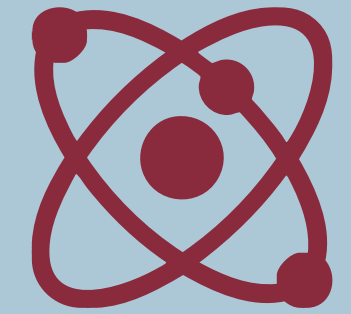

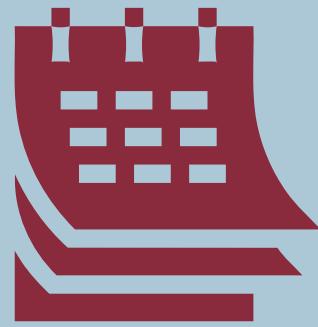
