



How to Register

Registering for an InvestIN programme is a simple, straightforward process.

- No application process
- Students don't require prior knowledge or experience in order to attend.
- Places are limited
- We are typically fully booked for summer programmes by late spring.



Complete the booking form

InvestIN provides our partners with a booking form to help enrol their students. This allows our team to process the applications as agency bookings, securing partners with the best deal for their clients.

Partners can complete the Partner Registration Form on behalf of their clients, or they can send the family the Parent/Guardian registration form to complete directly.

Invoicing and payment

Once a registration form has been submitted, the Student Experience Team receives it automatically, creates the invoices and send them to the relevant recipient.

Payment can be made directly through Flywire, or via bank transfer. Payment can be made in the following formats:

- £950 deposit, followed by the remaining amount.
- 50% deposit, followed by the remaining amount.
- 100% payment.



Student enrolment form

Once a student's place has been reserved, they will receive a student login to our portal, where they must provide their full information. Students can be assisted through this process directly by their parents, or their educational consultant can complete the information, through their own access to the form.




Pre-Programme

Programme Delivery

Our expert Programme Management and Operations teams work year-round on the organisation of our term-time and summer programmes. Programmes are led by our InvestIN Programme Managers, whilst the content is delivered by industry professionals from the relevant career fields, supported by current university students.

In the summer, our delivery team expands to onboard a cohort of seasonal staff, such as the Summer School Director, Centre Managers, Assistant Centre Managers and Pastoral and Activity Leaders. Many of our seasonal staff and industry professionals return to work with InvestIN every summer and are experienced with our systems, processes and settings.

Safeguarding & Pastoral

Our safeguarding and pastoral team (SPT) is made up of vetted, experienced professionals from safeguarding settings: education professionals/learning support assistants and safeguarding officers. During our Summer Experiences, students are supported by group leaders and the residential settings are overseen by centre managers, a 24/7 team of safeguarding officers and coordinators, as well as on-site specialist nurses.















International Students

A global student community

We have welcomed students to London from over 100 different countries. Our programmes offer international students a unique opportunity to experience both university and professional life in the UK before they leave school, whilst making lasting friendships with likeminded and ambitious peers.

Travelling to the UK

Students who require a visa to enter the UK will need to obtain a Standard Visitor Visa (the same used by tourists). InvestIN is accredited by the British Accreditation Council (BAC) and students can select a visa for "study at an accredited institution". We can provide everything you need to support your trip to the UK, from visa letters, to airport transfers, to a comprehensive residential package and an evening/weekend social programme filled with cultural and social activities.

English as a Foreign Language

We require a minimum English language level of B2 (upper-intermediate CEFR). Our programmes are delivered by native English speaking professionals, whilst over 50% of our students are from the UK and the US. This provides advanced English language learners with a fantastic opportunity to develop business-level oral and written communication, whether that's working on a project brief in a team, presenting to a group, networking with professionals or socialising with friends.

Frequently Asked Questions

When is the deadline for registering?

Places on our programmes are allocated on a first-come, first-served basis so we will close registration as soon as we reach capacity. We typically close registration for our Summer Experiences a couple of months in advance.

Do I need to have any prior industry experience?

You don't need any prior knowledge or experience to attend – our industry professionals will coach you on everything you need to know!

What age brackets are permitted?

Our programmes are designed for students aged 15-18. We cannot accept any students over the age of 18. Please contact us if you are slightly below the age bracket.

How will this help me with future university or job applications?

Attending an InvestIN programme will provide you with first-hand experience of your chosen field, equipping you with a variety of examples to reference in your application and in interviews that demonstrate your commitment, passion and potential to succeed.

Will I receive any certification?

Weekend programme attendees will receive a certificate, whilst our Summer Experience (min. 2-week) students also receive an industry reference letter and can be assessed for a Level 3 Award in Work Experience to receive 8 UCAS points.

UK students can also list InvestIN under the 'extra activities' section of the UCAS application form and make reference to the experiences gained in personal statements and interviews. We are also an approved activity provider for the Gold Residential section of the Duke of Edinburgh Award.

What nationalities attend the programmes?

Our Weekend Programmes are primarily attended by UK students. However, on our Summer Experiences, around 50% of our students are native English speakers from the UK or the US, whilst the remaining 50% travel to London from a wide range of different countries. To date, we have welcomed students onto InvestIN programmes from over 100 different countries, providing students with a fantastic opportunity to network with and befriend peers from a range of different backgrounds and cultures.



What is the difference between a Weekend Programme and a Summer Experience?

Our Weekend Programmes take place during termtime and are one day in length and typically run on Sundays in November and March. They are nonresidential. These programmes take place on UCL and UoL campuses and feature interactive masterclasses delivered by top professionals, career coaching and a live Q&A session.

Our Summer Experiences run during the summer holidays and provide a comprehensive, 360-degree experience of a field, featuring excursions to professional workplaces, whole days dedicated to industry specialisms, private networking and more. Residential packages are also available, including accommodation, breakfast & dinner, evening and weekend activities and 24/7 safeguarding and pastoral support

What is the difference between a 1-week, 2-week and 2-week Premium Summer Experience?

Our Summer Experiences take place during July and August. Residential students will arrive the Sunday before the programme starts and check-out on the Saturday after the programme finishes.

Our 1-week experiences include 25 hours of contact time with professionals, fully immersive, interactive simulations to explore a range of industry specialisms, as well as up to 2 excursions to professional workplaces.

Our 2-week experiences include an additional 25 hours of contact time (50 hours total), up to a total of 5 professional site visits, private networking sessions, a graduation ceremony and an industry reference letter.
