General 20

Intensive Courses

Before you leave, here are some important things to remember to ensure your arrival is as smooth as possible:

- Laptop/tablet
- SIM card that can be used in the US



Clothing

New York has a varied climate with humid Summers and cold and snowy winters, so we advise bringing a range of clothes suitable for all climates. Please bring waterproof clothing, a raincoat, and suitable footwear.

Our activity programme may include sporting events, so it is also a good idea to bring active wear suitable for the outdoors.

The average temperature is around 2 degrees in Winter and 25 degrees in Summer.

Pocket money

We recommend a weekly budget \$250 to cover local travel, lunch, and activities. Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in the US, but it is a good idea to bring some cash with you.

Check with your debit/credit card company that you are able to use your card and withdraw money in the US.

We do not advise carrying around large amounts of cash.

Bank account

If you are staying in America for three months or more you may wish to open a bank account. LSI can support you with this process when you arrive.

When you arrive

Arriving at a foreign airport can be overwhelming. There will be no LSI representative at the airport to meet you. Transfer information is sent prior to the trip with procedures to get the car for your transfer. The driver will be holding an LSI sign

with your name on it and will take you directly to your accommodation. If you can't find the driver or your flight is delayed, please inform the transfer company at the phone number provided in the transfer confirmation email as soon as possible.

Sometimes, customs and immigration may ask you to wait while they check your travel documents. Please don't worry if this happens, it is normal procedure to check student's visas. Be calm and polite. If there are any concerns at immigration, ask the office to call the LSI New York emergency phone: 347 891 3516.

If you have not booked an airport transfer, public transport can be found at all major airports for travel to New York. Alternatively, you can catch a taxi from the airports taxi rank.

First day information

Wednesday prior to the start of classes, an email will be sent from the school with important information and the link to the placement test. You will also receive log in details and instructions for our E-LSI platform where you can complete our pre-arrival level test. It is important that you take the test before your first day to ensure we have the correct class ready for you.

Classes begin at 9.10am but please report to reception for 9am, where we will be waiting to welcome you.



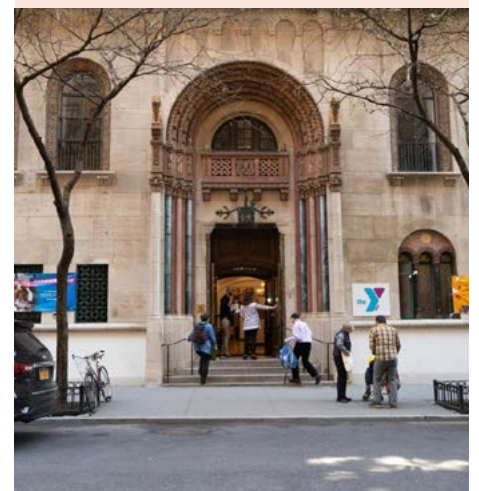

Homestay Accommodation

Staying with a host family is an excellent way for you to practise English and learn about American culture and New York City life. Here at LSI we carefully select and manage our own host families, ensuring high standards and a welcoming and friendly atmosphere. Commute time from homestays to LSI New York by public transport is between 40-60+ minutes.

Our Accommodation Co-ordinator is available to speak with you and to help whenever you need.

To help you prepare for your stay, please read the following information.

What will my room be like?

Every homestay is unique. You are not going to a hotel so each home will be different. However, we make sure that your room has the following: a bed, a chair, a table or desk, a table lamp, a mirror, a heating appliance and chest of drawers or similar and a wardrobe.

What services are included?

Your host will provide bed linen, towels, and will have laundry facilities available in the home or suggest local laundromats. Toiletries are not included so you will need to purchase these yourself.

Can I use the kitchen?

Your family will provide the meals you have requested through LSI, either Breakfast only or Breakfast and Dinner (Half Board). Students are allowed to use the kitchen for both food storage and cooking. If you have any dietary requirements or allergies please ensure you have informed LSI of these.

About homestay meals

Breakfast: Usually a light meal consisting of cereal, toast, spreads, fruit, yoghurt, and a choice of tea, coffee, and juice. Hosts will usually ask you to prepare your own breakfast.

Lunch: You will be responsible for buying your own lunch from a local restaurant or local shop. There are many cafes and shops close by, all within walking distance of the school.

Dinner: You will usually eat dinner with your host, unless you have arranged otherwise. Dinners should be varied and balanced and should include meat, fish or cheese, some

carbs, vegetables and a piece of fruit or dessert. In America most families have dinner between 6pm and 8pm. Your host will inform you of their dinner time and ask that you let them know if you will not be eating with them or do not require dinner.

Arrivals and Departures

At least one member of your family will be waiting at home to greet you on your arrival day. They will show you your room and share with you any house rules they may have; please respect these.

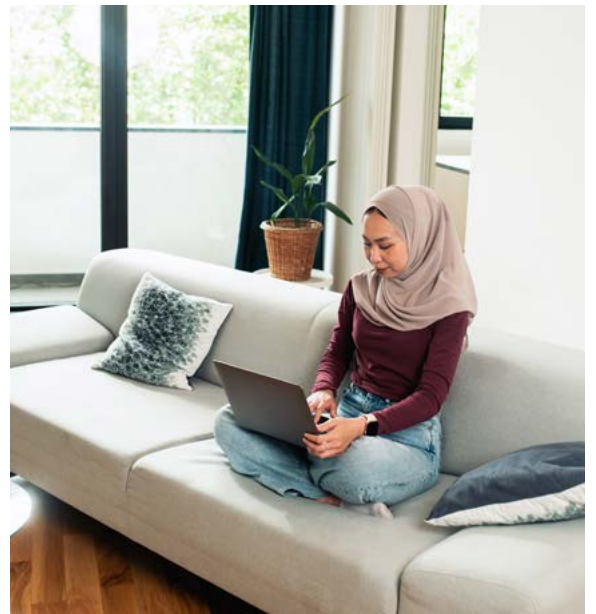

Clothing

English weather can be very unpredictable (even in Summer!), so we advise bringing a range of clothes suitable for all climates. Please bring waterproof clothing, a raincoat, and suitable footwear.

Our activity programme may include sporting events, so it is a good idea to bring active wear or clothing suitable for the outdoors.

The average temperature is around 5 degrees in Winter and 20 degrees in Summer.

Pocket money

We recommend a weekly budget of £150 to cover local travel, lunch, and activities. You will need additional money if you wish to take weekend trips. Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in Brighton, but it is a good idea to bring some cash with you.

Check with your debit/credit card company that you are able to use your card and withdraw money in the UK.

We do not advise carrying around large amounts of cash.

Bank account

If you are staying in the UK for three months or more you may wish to open a bank account. LSI can support you with this process when you arrive.

When you arrive

Arriving at a foreign airport can be overwhelming. If you get lost or confused, don't be afraid to ask the airport staff for help.

If you have booked an airport transfer, an LSI representative will meet you in the arrivals hall after baggage reclaim and immigration. They will be holding an LSI sign with your name on it and will take you directly to your accommodation. If you can't find the driver or your flight is delayed, please inform the transfer company at the phone number provided in the transfer confirmation email as soon as possible.

Sometimes, customs and immigration may ask you to wait while they check your travel documents. Please don't worry if this happens, it is normal procedure to check student's visas. Be calm and polite. If there are any concerns at immigration, ask the office to call the LSI Brighton emergency phone: +447593 371388.

If you have not booked an airport transfer, public transport can be found at all major airports for travel to Brighton. 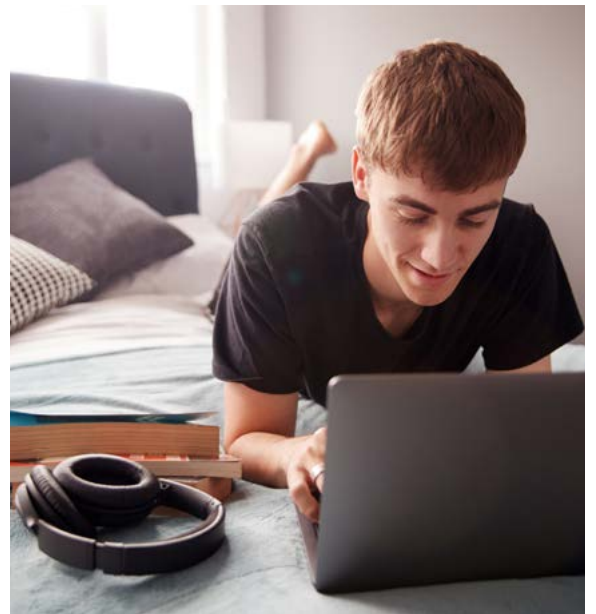

Departure Guide

Before you leave, here are some important things to remember to ensure your arrival is as smooth as possible:

Checklist

- Passport
- Letter of acceptance and LSI documentation
- Accommodation confirmation letter (either homestay profile or residence details)
- Proof of medical/health insurance
- £150 in cash and credit/debit cards
- Any prescription medication
- Adaptor for electrical appliances (Type G: 3 pin with standard voltage 230V)
- Laptop/tablet
- SIM card that can be used in the UK



Clothing

English weather can be very unpredictable (even in Summer!), so we advise bringing a range of clothes suitable for all climates. Please bring waterproof clothing, a raincoat, and suitable footwear.

Our activity programme may include sporting events, so it is a good idea to bring active wear or clothing suitable for the outdoors.

The average temperature is around 5 degrees in Winter and 20 degrees in summer.

Pocket money

We recommend a weekly budget of £250 to cover local travel, lunch, and activities. You will need additional money if you wish to take weekend trips. Credit and debit cards are widely accepted in London, but it is a good idea to bring some cash with you.

Check with your debit/credit card company that you are able to use your card and withdraw money in the UK.

We do not advise carrying around large amounts of cash.

Bank account

If you are staying in the UK for three months or more you may wish to open a bank account. LSI can support you with this process when you arrive.

When you arrive

Arriving at a foreign airport can be overwhelming. If you get lost or confused, don't be afraid to ask the airport staff for help.

If you have booked an airport transfer, an LSI representative will meet you in the arrivals hall after baggage reclaim and immigration. They will be holding an LSI sign with your

name on it and will take you directly to your accommodation. If you can't find the driver or your flight is delayed, please inform the transfer company at the phone number provided in the transfer confirmation email as soon as possible.

Sometimes, customs and immigration may ask you to wait while they check your travel documents. Please don't worry if this happens, it is normal procedure to check students' visas. Be calm and polite. If there are any concerns at immigration, ask the office to call the LSI London Central emergency phone: +44 (0) 759 771 2277.

If you have not booked an airport transfer, public transport can be found at all major airports. From London Heathrow and London City airports, it is easy to get to any place in London by public transport. Gatwick, Stansted, and Luton airports are outside of the boundary of Greater London, and you would then need to travel to London by train or coach. The National Express coach service is often the cheapest mode of transport with coach stops in every terminal where you can buy tickets.

First day information

Two weeks before your arrival date LSI will email you welcome information with details on how to get to school and what your first day will look like. You will also receive log in details and instructions for our E-LSI platform where you can complete our pre-arrival level test. It is important that you take the test before your first day to ensure we have the correct class ready for you.

Classes begin at 9.15am but please report to reception for 8.30am, where we will be waiting to welcome you.

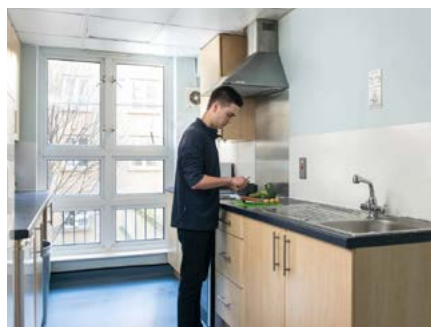

Staying with a host family is an excellent way for you to practise English and learn about British life. Here at LSI we carefully select and manage our own host families, ensuring high standards and a welcoming and friendly atmosphere. Commute time from homestays to LSI Central by public transport can be up to 60 minutes.

Our Accommodation Co-ordinator is available to speak with you and to help whenever you need.

To help you prepare for your stay, please read the following information.

What will my room be like?

Every homestay is unique. You are not going to a hotel so each home will be different. However, we make sure that your room has the following: a bed, a chair, a table or desk, a table lamp, a mirror, a heating appliance and chest of drawers or similar and a wardrobe.

What services are included?

Your host will provide bed linen, towels, and will wash your laundry once per week. Toiletries are not included so you will need to purchase these yourself.

Can I use the kitchen?

Your family will provide the meals you have requested through LSI, either Breakfast only or Breakfast and Dinner (Half Board). Families will not usually allow you to use the kitchen to cook your own food or to store a lot of items in their fridge. If you have any dietary requirements or allergies please ensure you have informed LSI of these.

About homestay meals

Breakfast: Usually a light meal consisting of cereal, toast, spreads, fruit, yoghurt, and a choice of tea, coffee, and juice. Hosts will usually ask you to prepare your own breakfast.

Lunch: You will be responsible for buying your own lunch from a local restaurant or local shop. There are many cafes and shops all within walking distance of the school.

Dinner: You will usually eat dinner with your host, unless you have arranged otherwise. Dinners should be varied and balanced and should include meat, fish or cheese, some carbs, vegetables and a piece of fruit or
