# Junior course information 2026

## Registration and homestay placement fee information

All courses include a registration and homestay placement fee to cover the cost of the time required to enrol the student on the course, process the prearrival English level placement test, place them in the best class, and find them a suitable homestay (if required).

## Course information

### Course fees include:

- Pre-arrival English level placement test
- Tuition hours as specified
- Walking and orientation tour of Southbourne high street on first day
- Course books and teaching materials (£50 book supplement applied to all 1 week courses)
- A safe to deposit passports, tickets and money
- Services of our Welfare Officer for information, advice and help on personal and medical matters
- Free Wi-Fi and internet access throughout the school
- End-of-course certificate

## Junior General English courses

You can book onto our Junior Summer English Courses for a minimum of one week but many students choose to stay for longer. Students have 15 one-hour lessons each week, from Monday to Friday. Classes are small, averaging 12 students per class (maximum 16).

## Summer Activities

Our summer activities are available during our summer season, from 14<sup>th</sup> June to 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2026. It is included in our Summer General English+ courses, our fun and varied activity programme, with local trips, sports activities, Saturday full day excursions, and selected evening activities. ## Summer Collective Transfers

Summer collective transfers are not available for any students using the Unaccompanied Minor Service with airline on arrival or departure. Students that require assistance with check in on departure will be charged an additional £80 which includes 1 hour wait with taxi driver. Additional hours charged at £35 per hour. Flight details must be sent and paid two weeks before arrival

## Special educational needs / mental health issues

At the time of booking, we MUST be told about ANY special educational needs and/or mental health issues. These include but are not limited to: ADHD, Dyslexia, and Asperger's Syndrome

As much information as possible should be given so we can assess if we are able to accept the student.

If a student arrives with special educational needs that we have not been told about and we are not able to teach/integrate them successfully, we will have to cancel their course. Students will be sent home at their own expense, but remaining course fees will be refunded. Check Terms & Conditions

## Accommodation

**Private foster family homestay:** Due to UK laws protecting children under the age of 16, students aged 10 – 15 staying longer than 27 nights will need to be placed with a family that is registered as a private foster family with social services.

### Homestay accommodation information:

- Only available for students aged 10+
- Full board accommodation (twin room, breakfast and dinner from hosts and freshly prepared packed lunch from school Monday to Friday. Saturday and Sunday from host family.
- Light laundry once a week
- All within walking distance or a short bus journey from the school
- 15-year-olds must follow a 10pm (22:00) curfew, 13 and 14 year-olds must follow a 9pm (21:00) curfew, and 12-year-olds are not allowed out unsupervised. No exceptions.
- All families hosting under 18-year-olds are police checked (DBS)
- All families who host our junior students are chosen for their friendly and caring attitude
- All junior students may share a room with another student of a similar age and same gender and possibly same nationality during busy periods

## Extras and supplements

**Under 12 surcharge:** This charge is to cover additional staffing costs required by UK law for individual students

## Airport Transfers (Private)

- Unaccompanied Minor Service is required for junior students who are too young to fly unaccompanied - this is determined by the airline and the age of the students varies, so please check with the airline you have booked with. There will be an additional charge of £120 which includes check in at the airline counter and a wait of up to 2 hours by the driver. Additional hours are charged at £40/hour.
- Pick up point will be confirmed with you when we have the flight details.
- On arrival, a £40/hour waiting charge is applied if the driver has to wait longer than 2 hours after the flight landing time.
- UK Border Agency may refuse to allow students under 18 into the UK unless they have written parental consent to travel or have proof of their onward travel arrangements
