Culinary Department/Restaurant Worker- Student will be washing dishes, light food prep work such as cutting veggies, and could potentially learn salads, desserts, and pizza making.

Housekeeping Department- Student will be cleaning rooms, bathrooms, and common areas of hotel. They will sweep and hose down the outside veranda/porch area. They will assist in taking care of flowers and plants around the property. They will strip down the rooms and gather all dirty linens for laundry service, and will assist with unbag and putting linens away when they are returned after cleaning. Students will also need to complete a daily housekeeping report and report any room issues to department manager. Will also assist with light maintenance and simple daily tasks such as changing a light bulb, taking out the trash, replacing small furniture in the room that might get damaged during a guest's stay.
