Job Description:

All students will be trained in all aspects of bakery operations. Students will be expected to work in all three roles as business needs dictate. The three main positions students will work in are:

Host/Cashier - wages start at \$5 per hour.

Duties include: greeting customers, answering customer questions on menu, taking customer orders, enter orders into system accurately, taking cash or credit card payments and giving correct change, ensuring work space is clean and tidy at all times, assisting with preparing beverages or other menu items according to restaurant specifications, ensuring customer complaints or issues are communicated to management, restocking workstations and other side work as needed, and other duties as assigned.

Bussing/Dishwashing - wages start at \$6 per hour.

Duties include: collecting dirty dishes from dish stations or guest tables, resetting silverware supplies or guest tables, clearing finished tables in an expedient manner, washing all dirty dishes according to restaurant standards, or other duties as assigned.

Kitchen Help/Prep - wages start at \$12 per hour.

Duties include: maintaining a clean and safe workspace, preparing menu items in accordance with restaurant recipes, other duties as assigned.

Students will be scheduled for opening and closing shifts. Hours will fall between 6:30am - 4:30pm.
