Back of House employees are required to perform various food and beverage related tasks including: Cooking or preparing food items according to procedures or recipes. All items must be prepared quickly and accurately ensuring no waste and in accordance with production and portion requirement and quality standards while maintaining a safe, sanitary work environment. All food and beverage employees will be responsible for maintaining and cleaning all food service areas including preparation tables, equipment, dishes, floors, supply areas, refrigerators, coolers, sales areas, and customer areas (tables, chairs, serving lines, condiment stands, etc.) Keep supervisor/manager informed of situations relating to facility operation, patron complaints or concerns, accidents, emergency situations, damages and potential safety hazards. Perform all duties in a safe manner. Employees may be asked to move to different locations or job assignments within the property, as needed. Other duties may be assigned.

All staff must have a high attention to detail, math/ counting skills, and accurate money/cash handling skills. Must be able to work individually or on a team and at a quick pace. Must have the ability to read, write and understand instructions given in the English language. Must have the ability to understand and respond to verbal instructions in the English language.
