

Highland Lake Resort - Housekeeper

HOST INFORMATION

Company Description:

Highland Lake Resort is located on a beautiful five acre lot with sloping lawn to 400 feet of waterfront on Highland Lake. We have 23 hotel rooms, lawn games, a gym, saunas, a labyrinth, an onsite cafe, an obstacle course and more. While employees are not permitted to hang out at the Resort when not working there are abundant things to do less than a mile away.

The town center is less than one mile away and there are: a dozen shops in town, two grocery stores, a local movie theater, a beautiful swimming beach, hiking trails with free obstacle course at Pondicherry Park and occasionally live music but we are NOT a city (town population of 5,000). This is a low key, relaxed town with a significant tourist population in the summer. This is ideal for students who want a cultural experience without living in a frenzied city.

There is a bus you can pay \$6 for a round trip from Bridgton, Maine to Portland, Maine (ocean side city- population 66,500) about an hour drive away. We will take students once a month on adventures to explore the area and/or to attend performing arts events depending on the students interest.

We had a lovely young woman from Turkey stay with us in 2019. She worked in our cafe and shared an apartment with my son and I. For our 2022 season we invited 3 students to share that apartment by themselves. There is one bedroom with three beds, a private bathroom, living room and kitchen area.

Job Description:

The position is between the hours of 9-3 Sun-Sat.

The duties include but are not limited to the following:

- Being kind to coworkers, guests, other vendors
- Report to supervisor for daily tasks and room assignment. Collect any information regarding guest requests, to-do items
- Following and maintaining cleaning schedule & priorities list
- Uses checklists to indicate tasks completed
- Communicates with front desk and office staff on room status
- Keep cart inventory stocked and organized at all times.
- Clean all guestrooms to the satisfaction of the housekeeping supervisor and in accordance with the standards and policies of the

company.

- Removing dirty linens, towels, trash, recyclables and guest items left in rooms
- Cleaning bathrooms by cleaning the tub, toilet, and sinks; removing used towels and bathmats; replacing bath linens.
- Vacuuming and washing floors
- Dusting and polishing furniture; cleaning windows and glass surfaces.
- Maintain laundry area and storage closets, keeping them cleaned and organized
- Preparing and sorting laundry for pick-up
- Stocking & replenishing each room with necessary toiletries, linens and towels.
- Conserves energy by closing shades and draperies; turning down air conditioning and heat of unoccupied rooms.
- Ensure all guest room floors, hallways, porches and public areas are cleaned.
- Keeps supplies ready by restocking housekeeping cart at end of the shift.
- Keeps equipment operating by following operating instructions; troubleshooting breakdowns; maintaining supplies; performing preventive maintenance; calling for repairs.
- Maintains safe, secure, and healthy work environment by following and enforcing standards and procedures; complying with security regulations.
