When you arrive, you can pick your bed/bedroom. First come/first serve - if a change is needed, you will have to work with the other employees to arrange. Housing includes, TV, refrigerator, microwave, some cookware, full kitchen, one bathroom, linens are provided for bedding and bathroom. Laundry facilities are located in a couple places around town (we will show you when you get here) Housing is just across the street from the store, maybe 200 yards walk.

There are multiple laundry facilities in town - the closest is 2 block away - all are coin laundry that cost approximately \$4 per load (or that is what they were in 2023)

This is a shared cabin. There is one room that is only a single. There are 2 rooms for 2 with one bunk bed each. There is a room that houses 6 and has 3 bunk beds. You can room with whoever you want. Housing is co-ed. Rooms will not be co-ed, unless you travel together and want to be roomed together.

Jeans or shorts and a t-shirt are the "uniform". We just request that you look presentable to be in front of customers. No open toed shoes allowed.

Applicable Company Policies:

General job conditions -

- Shifts are either 7am-2pm, 10am-5pm or 2pm-9pm (sometimes we will stay open later as the year progresses)
- Once schedules are set, they are set for the summer to allow for 2nd jobs as needed
- This job takes priority over a second job, if I can make the schedule work I will
- Breaks are only allowed when there are multiple employees (no breaks from 7am-10am), limit of 2 short breaks (5-10 minutes) per shift
- Smoking not allowed on property or in housing
- Cell phones must remain unused during work hours unless needed for an emergency

If you are caught on the phone, you will be asked to leave for the day.

If you aren't working during your shift, you will be asked to leave for the day.

General housing conditions -

- All students live in 1 house
- Anywhere from 4-10 students
- Cleaning must be kept up weekly there are weekly housing checks
- No smoking or alcohol permitted in housing (alcohol permitted only if ALL residents are over 21)
- No overnight guests
- Quiet hours are from 10pm-8am daily
