There are two options for your travel to West Yellowstone MT. You can fly into Bozeman Montana (BZN) which is 90 miles from West Yellowstone. It may be more expensive and may have less options of flights than Salt Lake City. westyellowstonefoundation.org would be the transportation from the Bozeman airport. We are also available to pick up students from the Bozeman Airport only with our personal vehicle at no cost. We recommend that students fly into Salt lake City. (SLC) which is about 300 miles away from West Yellowstone. The saltlakeexpress.com provides shuttle service to and from the Salt Lake Airport. They drop students off at the Visitors Center in West Yellowstone and we will pick the student up and take them to their housing. Students MUST email their arrival information to Kaitlyn Mathews at runningbearwest@gmail.com about 2 WEEKS prior to arrival to the United States. Details about a scheduled pickup will be communicated to the student prior to their departure.
