Lifeguards are responsible for guarding swimmers and for the safe and efficient operations of our aquatics areas. This includes enforcing rules, giving information and answering questions, watching the pools and water slides to make sure that all guests are safe, performing life-saving techniques when needed as described and practiced in lifeguard certification training.

Students need to plan on arriving and scheduling their arrival appointment on the date listed as their first date per their DS 2019. Students will need to find transportation from the airport to Staff Services (381 E Austin ST New Braunfels, TX 78130) for onboarding during business hours.

If flights arrive outside of business hours, student will need to find a hotel for the evening and return on next day of operation - keep in contact with your host company on arrival changes. At the end of onboarding, you will be given the information for your assigned housing. You will need to find your own transportation from the Staff Services office to your designated complex. You will not be able to check-in to housing prior to your arrival appointment - this is also your first paid day of work.

TRAINING AND ONBOARDING

Pre-Arrival Onboarding: Yes

Participants must log-in to their associate life portal and complete their housing application, pay for the application fee (non-refundable), read and sign the housing contract, and pay the housing deposit before arriving to their assigned housing in Texas.

Participants are responsible for their rent through their agreed upon contract end date, based on the date on your DS 2019. Housing application end date cannot exceed 2 days past your DS 2019 end date OR 2 days past the last operating date.

If the participant chooses to leave prior to the agreed upon date, rent will continue to be deducted through the end date.

Staff Services will schedule your Social Security Office appointment when you come in for onboarding and will send you a confirmation email with meeting location, date, and time. We will provide transportation to and from the Social Security Office. Students will need to find transportation to the Staff Services Offices on the date of your scheduled appointment. Appointments can take several hours so you may want to bring something to read or earphones to listen to music. Once application is complete, your Social Security Card will be mailed (Takes approximately 2 to 3 weeks). If you do not receive the card within 3 weeks of your appointment, please call the Social Security Administration at (800) 445-0831. Very Important: You will need to have your Social Security Card mailed to 381 E. Austin St., New Braunfels, TX, 78130. We will contact you once we receive your Social Security Card.
