Taxi from Logan Airport is not recommended, it will be very, very expensive.

From Hyannis, you may wish get to your housing by the Cape Cod Transit Bus: https://capecodrta.org/, by a taxi/Uber/Lyft or by making arrangements with your landlord or host. Please note that the Cape Cod Transit Bus runs on a limited schedule until mid-June. If your flight arrives after 8:00 PM in the evening, you may want to stay in the city that you've landed in (New York or Boston) as in the evening hours, transportation to Cape Cod and to your living accommodations may be difficult with the bus schedules. If possible, it is best to book a flight that lands in the morning in Boston.
