Student will arrive in MSP airport.

Board bus terminal on site at the MSP airport where you will board the Jefferson Lines bus to Jackson, Minnesota. The bus tickets may be purchased day of departure. This will be a 3 hour bus ride.

Jefferson Lines Scheduled bus service is available through Jefferson Lines. Tickets are available at the Jefferson Lines ticket counter, as well as online at www.jeffersonlines.com. Buses pick up and drop off passengers at Terminal 1 in the Transit Center on Level 1 of the Silver Ramp. To pick up or drop off a Jefferson Lines passenger at the airport, you can park in the Red or Blue Ramp or use the Upper East Roadway where the hotel shuttles drop off passengers. Non-commercial vehicles are not allowed in the Ground Transport Center.

I will pick you up at the Jackson, Minnesota bus terminal and drive you to Okoboji. This is a 20 minute drive.

I will also drive students to the Social Security office.

Housing is within a short walking distance of work and leisure. Shopping and banking are also within walking distance. There are several options for transportation by vehicle including rideshare and taxi. Rides company specializes in transportation for work and shopping. RIDES (nwiarides.org).
